

## Attention Visual Art MFAs

### Call for Entries: 2011 Murphy and Cadogan Fellowships in the Fine Arts

The Murphy and Cadogan Fellowships provide tuition awards of \$3,500 to Masters in Fine Arts (MFA) visual art students studying at one of these eight Northern California MFA programs: Academy of Art University, California College of the Arts, John F. Kennedy University, Mills College, San Francisco Art Institute, San Francisco State University, Stanford University, and UC Berkeley. Visual artists working in all mediums are invited to apply. There is no fee to apply.

The awards are designed to support MFAs in the second or third year of graduate studies. Students must be currently enrolled in a university. They should have one semesters of studies completed and be enrolled in their program through December 2011. The selected artists will be invited to participate in an exhibition at the main gallery of SOMArts. One of the winning artists will receive the Jurors' Choice Award, an additional \$3,500 award for outstanding accomplishments and promise.

The 2011 Jack & Gertrude Murphy Fellowships in the Fine Arts and the 2011 Edwin Anthony & Adelaine Bordeaux Cadogan Fellowships in the Fine Arts are administered by The San Francisco Foundation in partnership with SOMArts.
